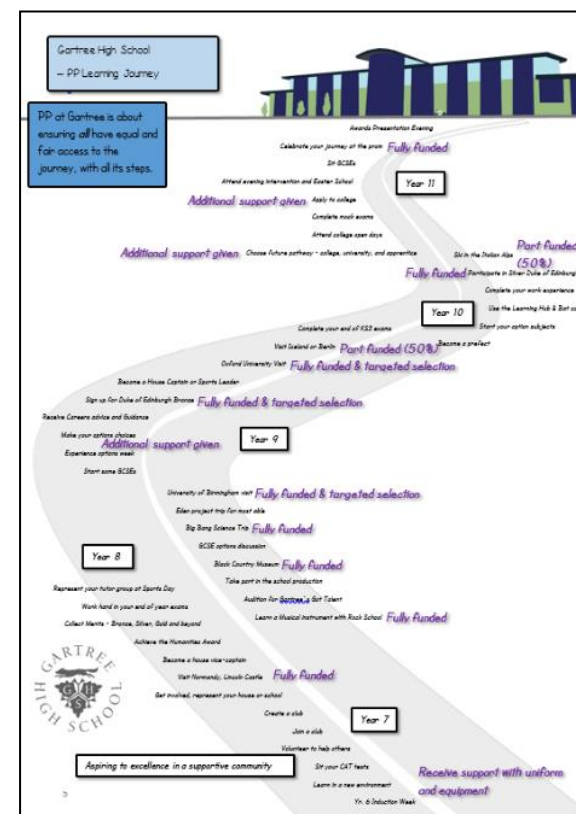

### BARRIERS TO FUTURE ATTAINMENT

#### Academic barriers:

Higher levels of challenge for all students including PP

Aspirations and level of 'drive' shown by some disadvantaged students towards their education and future

Closing of a historic gap in attainment from primary education

### ADDITIONAL BARRIERS

#### External barriers

Attendance of disadvantaged students – Lower than that of non PP students

Lack of opportunities for students to explore their studies and interests away from Gartree High School

Access educational resources within and beyond Gartree High School
